Carlik Jones led the African team's comeback with 19 points, and the crowning moment for South Sudan was Wenyen Gabriel's rousing dunk a minute from time. Cuba's twice Olympic champion Julio Cesar La Cruz was eliminated from the men's heavyweight competition on Sunday following a 3-2 split decision defeat by Loren Alfonso of Azerbaijan. PLA soldiers acclimatize themselves before joint exercise in Tanzania

Troops from the People's Liberation Army participating in the "Peace Unity-2024" joint exercise in Tanzania have begun to carry out training to acclimatize themselves to the local environment, according to the PLA. Infantrymen from the Chinese military started checking and surveying their drill zones at the Tanzania People's Defence Forces' Comprehensive Training Center in Mapinga of Bagamoyo District on Saturday. conducted tactical training at the center over the past two days, using armed fighting vehicles and self-propelled assault guns transported from China, according to the PLA Central Theater Command. The command said in a news release on Sunday that starting Monday, infantry troops from China and Tanzania are scheduled to perform joint command and tactical training. The militaries of China, Tanzania and Mozambique will hold "Peace Unity-2024" joint exercise from late-July to mid-August, according to China's Ministry of National Defense. China Daily.

Chinese Economic Ties and Low-carbon Industrialization in Africa

Since the establishment of the Forum on China-Africa Cooperation (FOCAC) in 2000 and the China-Africa Development Fund in 2006, China's economic ties with Africa have grown and deepened significantly. However, China's deepening connections and in particular, its foreign direct investment (FDI), in Africa have been the subject of discussion regarding their composition, goals, nature and implications for the continent's industrial and economic development. How does Chinese FDI influence the carbon intensity of the manufacturing sector in African recipient countries? A new working paper by Solomon Owusu, Keyi Tang and Gideon Ndubuisi examines the impact of Chinese FDI on low-carbon industrialization in Africa, within the context of China's growing economic ties with the continent. The analysis relies on a panel dataset comprising Chinese FDI into the manufacturing sectors of 34 African countries from 2003-2014, using deal-level FDI data from the FDI Intelligence Data developed by the Financial Times. China, 26 African countries to jointly innovate in digital world

China and 26 African countries on Monday issued an action plan on digital cooperation and development, aiming to boost digital policy, infrastructure, cutting-edge innovation, transformation, security and nurturing of talents. Over the next three years, the countries will work together to implement 10 digital transformation demonstration projects and train at least 1,000 personnel in the field. CGTN.
