#### Experts, officials say China-Africa cooperation drives sustainable growth

Kenya on Tuesday hosted the 21st China Lecture Series, a forum where participants underscored the mutual benefits of China-Africa cooperation in advancing sustainable development through the Belt and Road Initiative (BRI). Erastus Mwencha, former deputy chairperson of the African Union Commission, pointed out that Africa could draw valuable insights from China's modernization path, as both face similar development challenges and can benefit from shared solutions. ## China's Copper Play in Africa: High Stakes, Riches, and Risks in Congo and Zambia

As the world's appetite for copper intensifies, a new report by the Nonferrous Metals Research Institute at the China International Capital Corporation (中金有色研究) — a partially state-owned Chinese investment management and financial services company — examines China's role in the rapidly evolving copper mining sector in Zambia and the Democratic Republic of the Congo. Researchers from the institute spent two weeks touring both countries from September 3-14, 2024, and visited seven mining companies, twelve mines, three smelters and met with officials from two contractors. With its unique reserves and recent influx of foreign investment, the DRC has quickly become the world's second-largest copper producer, trailing only Chile. China Global South Project.

#### Taiwan's Shrinking Footprint in Africa Amid Chinese Pressure

The recent decision by South Africa's newly formed Government of National Unity (GNU) to relocate the unofficial Taiwanese embassy, known as the "Taipei Liaison Office," from Pretoria to Johannesburg reflects pressure from the Chinese government and forceful imposition of its One China principle. The instruction to rename the liaison office as a trade office further underscores the non-diplomatic nature of the relationship, aligning with China's concerted efforts to isolate and intimidate Taiwan globally. Ultimately, there was little Taiwan could have done to prevent this outcome. Despite its historical ties to South Africa's apartheid regime, Taiwan has struggled to maintain its influence since the formation of the Black-majority government led by the African National Congress (ANC). ### Africa a 'major part' in global green economy

The African continent requires bold interventions to break the barriers preventing countries from accessing the funds they need for climate action and a fair and just transition, experts said. Speaking ahead of the COP29 United Nations Climate Change Conference, which will convene from Nov 11 to Nov 22 in Baku, Azerbaijan, experts argued that African countries must chart their unique paths toward achieving such change. Nathalie Delapalme, CEO of the Mo Ibrahim Foundation, said that when addressing fair transition in the upcoming COP29 meeting, it is important for parties to recognize that this should refer to equitable and sustainable energy practices for both the developed and underdeveloped countries. ### Heightened Competition in the African Phone Market Weighs on Transsion Profits

Shenzhen-based mobile phone giant Transsion Holdings has dominated the African market for over a decade, outpacing Samsung, Apple, and a handful of other Chinese brands. But now, the maker of Tecno, Itel, and Infinix brand phones say their rivals are catching up and hammering the company's profits. On Monday, the company announced a stunning 40% drop in third-quarter profits compared to the same time last year. Total revenue for the quarter came in at \$2.3 billion, down 7.2% compared to Q3 2023. Transsion officials blamed increased competition in the African market and higher supply chain costs for the sharp downturn in profits. China Global South Project.

#### China donates cultural centre to FCT school
