

Nigeria, China sign €7.6b clean energy deal

Nigeria and China have signed a €7.6 billion (Euros) green hydrogen energy deal that will lead to a gradual transition from fossil fuels to clean energy, in line with global best practices. The agreement was signed at the weekend in Uyo, the Akwa Ibom State capital, between the Federal Government, APPL Hydrogen Limited (AHL), and a Chinese firm, LONGi Green Energy Technology Company Limited (LGETCL). India, China, Nigeria, Ghana top missing student cases in Canada

A recent report has revealed that nearly 50,000 foreign students failed to enrol in their designated institutions after arriving in Canada, with Indian students accounting for the largest share of untracked cases. According to data from Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC), 19,582 Indian students did not enrol, followed by 4,279 Chinese students, 3,902 Nigerian students, and 2,712 Ghanaian students.
